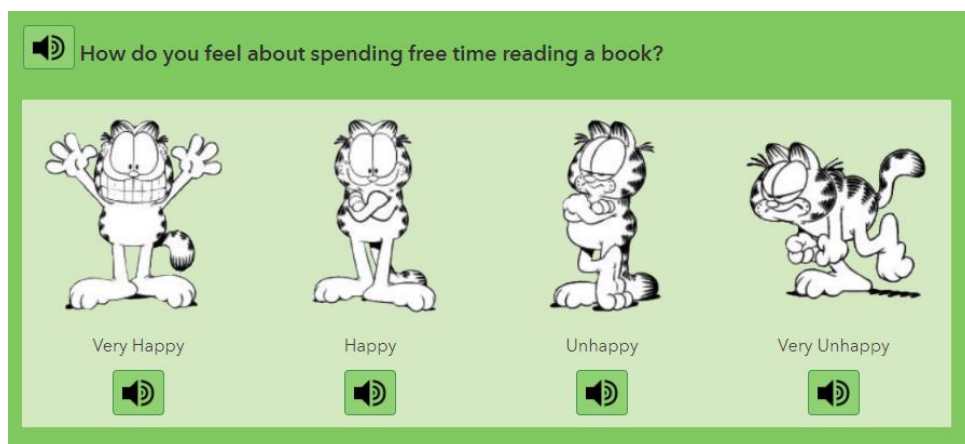


Dear parent/guardian,

the school uses a web-based survey system called Skólapúlsinn to monitor its operations and improve the school. One important part of that self-evaluation is asking children aged in Grades 1 through 5 10 questions about their enjoyment of reading and 10 statements about well-being in school. An example of an enjoyment of reading questions is: “How do you feel about spending free time reading a book?”. An example of a well-being statement is “I feel people are friendly.”



Students answer the survey anonymously online with a text-to-speech support in Icelandic and English (see picture). Each student takes part in April each year and it takes 10 minutes to complete the survey. Results are only displayed as means and ratios for groups. The self-evaluation system has been reported to the Data Protection Authority with the number S5590. No personal information is collected in Skólapúlsinn so it is not possible to see how any particular student answers.
